Application for Admission to Foundation Degree

Application may be made in one of the following ways:

- Application to full-time courses should be made through UCAS during the standard admissions cycle (September to June). In the case of students who already have their results, application to full-time courses can be made after this time by asking the college/university for a record of prior acceptance (RPA), which they will submit to UCAS on the student's behalf.
- Applications for part-time study should be made directly to the college/university.
- The LLN recognises that formal qualifications may not be the only acceptable/useful way of assessing suitability for higher education study. As a result, applicants may complete, along with a member of college/university staff, an "Admissions Equivalence Form", which will indicate the way in which a student's skills and/or experience are deemed equivalent to formal qualifications for entry purposes.

Admission to Foundation Degree

- If the applicant satisfies the conditions stipulated above, they are guaranteed an interview for their chosen Foundation Degree.
- In most circumstances, the applicant may choose a different course at the time of application if they have had a change of mind or career direction.
- The college/university are committed to providing pre-application and pre-entry advice and guidance to any student who requires or requests it.

The offer of a full-time place may be deferred for a one-year time period for students wishing to undertake a gap year, after which time, a new application must be submitted through UCAS.

Termination of Agreement

This progression agreement will terminate if:

- the course at is redesigned and, following discussions between University of Chester and course tutors, it is agreed an appropriate curriculum match no longer exists; or
- the course at is discontinued. Should this occur would undertake to provide comprehensive information, advice and guidance on other progression opportunities.

Although it has been agreed by the and that the course you have chosen is an appropriate route to the Foundation Degree in there are also other opportunities available to you within our network in this curriculum area. Subject to you passing the course and meeting entry criteria you could also consider a range of alternative FDs or BA/BSc programmes.
